

BRIDGE CLEARANCE REDUCED: COLDWATER ROAD UNDER I-17 IN BLACK CANYON CITY

The I-17 bridge clearance over Coldwater Road will be reduced to 13 feet 6 inches beginning at 5 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 9, as part of the I-17 Improvement Project. The reduced bridge clearance will be in effect for several months.

DETOUR: Vehicles taller than 13 feet 6 inches will need to use the following detour routes beginning Friday, Aug. 9, at 5 a.m.

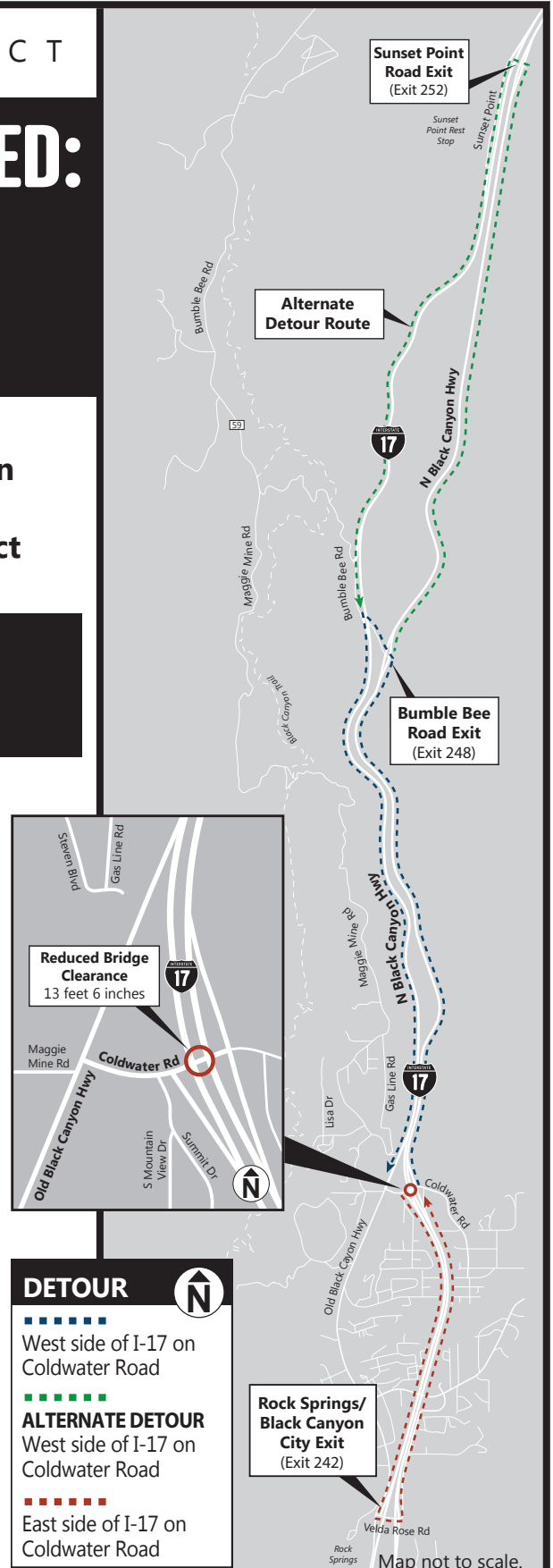
NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC:

- To access the area west of I-17 on Coldwater Road from northbound I-17, vehicles over 13 feet 6 inches should exit northbound I-17 at Bumble Bee Road (exit 248) and take the southbound I-17 on-ramp at Bumble Bee Road. Exit southbound I-17 at Coldwater Road (exit 244).
- Depending on additional work in the project corridor, this alternate detour route may be in place on certain days:** To access the area west of I-17 on Coldwater Road from northbound I-17, vehicles over 13 feet 6 inches should exit northbound I-17 at Sunset Point (Exit 252) and take the southbound I-17 ramp at Sunset Point. Exit southbound I-17 at Coldwater Road (exit 244).

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC:

- To access the area east of I-17 on Coldwater Road from southbound I-17, vehicles over 13 feet 6 inches should exit southbound I-17 at Rock Springs/Black Canyon City (exit 242) and take the northbound I-17 ramp at Rock Springs/Black Canyon City. Exit northbound I-17 at Coldwater Road (exit 244).
